Cancellation fees are as follows: more than 150 days prior to departure a \$300 administration fee and any airline, ground operator, or event deposits withheld may apply; 45 days – 30% of the tour cost plus the administration fee and any airline, ground operator, or event deposits as stated above; 31 days 75% of the total cost plus any airline, ground operator, or event deposits as stated above; 7 days 80% of the total cost plus any airline, ground operator, or event deposits as stated above; 7 days departure 100% of the total cost. All cancellations must be submitted in writing to Ave Maria Pilgrimage Tours, Inc.

## — ITINERARY —

**DAY 1 — MONDAY, JUNE 9** Afternoon departure on United Airlines from Denver to Washington Dulles airport, connecting for our evening flight to Lisbon.

**DAY 2 — TUESDAY, JUNE 10 LISBON – SANTAREM – FATIMA** Arrival in Lisbon, we will meet our English-speaking guide and enjoy a panorama tour of Lisbon. Afterwards, we will proceed to Santarem for Holy Mass and revere the 12th century Eucharistic miracle. Arrive in Fatima for dinner and overnight at Domus Pacis hotel.

**DAY 3 — WEDNESDAY, JUNE 11 FATIMA – SURROUNDING REGION** After breakfast, we depart for Holy Mass at St. Anthony's parish church where Lucia, Francisco and Jacinta were baptized. Afterwards, we continue with a visit to Aljustrel, the home of the seers and Valinhos, where the apparition of August 19th took place. We will take a break for lunch, on your own. In the afternoon, we will continue our tour of the Sanctuary and the Basilica of the Most Holy Rosary, where the three shepherds are buried. Dinner and overnight at Domus Pacis hotel. Every night while in Fatima we will have the opportunity to join the 9:30 AM international rosary and candlelight procession.

**DAY 4 — THURSDAY, JUNE 12 FATIMA – VIA CRUCIS** We will join fellow English-speaking pilgrims for 8:30 AM Holy Mass in the Capelinha (Chapel of the Apparitions), afterwards, we return to our hotel for breakfast. At 10:00 am we will walk the beautiful Stations of the Cross. The rest of the afternoon and lunch is on your own. Dinner and overnight at Domus Pacis hotel.

**DAY 5 — FRIDAY, JUNE 13 FATIMA** Today we join the many pilgrims from around the world for the 13th event day celebrations. The day starts with breakfast at our hotel. **9:00 AM** - International Rosary at the Chapel of the Apparitions. **10:00 AM** - procession to the main altar of the main Square for the concelebrated International Mass, with blessing of the sick and farewell procession after Mass. The rest of the day is free to spend in Fatima at your leisure. Dinner and overnight at Domus Pacis hotel.

**DAY 6 — SATURDAY, JUNE 14 BATALHA – NAZARE – ALCOBACA** We start the day with Holy Mass and breakfast. Today we will visit the great monument church in Batalha built to commemorate St. Nuno's great military victory and we will visit the 12th century monastery of Alcobaca. We will end our day in the beautiful coastal town of Nazare. Dinner and overnight at Domus Pacis hotel.

**DAY 7 — SUNDAY, JUNE 15 FATIMA** Morning Holy Mass at Domus Pacis Latin chapel or you can participate in the International Mass. The rest of the day is free to explore and experience the spirituality of Fatima. Dinner and overnight at Domus Pacis hotel.

**DAY 8 — MONDAY, JUNE 16 FATIMA – BRAGA** This is our last morning in Fatima, we will start with a 7:00 am group Mass in the Capelinha, then return to Domus Pacis for breakfast. 9:00 am departure for Braga, where we will visit the beautiful church of Bom Jesu. Along the way we will stop for lunch (on your own). Dinner and overnight in Braga.

**DAY 9 — TUESDAY, JUNE 17 BRAGA – TUI – PONTEVEDRA** After breakfast, we travel to Pontevedra and Tui, Spain, where the 1925 and 1929 apparitions occurred. Sister Lucia, the last Fatima seer, experienced the First Saturday Devotion in Pontevedra and the Last Vision in Tui. We will celebrate Mass in the Chapel of the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Dinner and overnight in Santiago de Compostela.

**DAY 10 — WEDNESDAY, JUNE 18 SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA** After breakfast, we attend 9:30 AM Mass at St. James Cathedral with fellow pilgrims. Then, we explore Santiago, visiting Obradoiro Square, the Cathedral, and nearby squares. After lunch (on your own), we continue through the historic center, Fonesca, Toural, and Alameda. Dinner and overnight in Santiago de Compostela.

**DAY 11 — THURSDAY, JUNE 19 BALASAR** After breakfast, we will depart for Balasar Portugal, where we will have a guided tour of the home of Blessed Alexandrina de Costa. At 12 noon we will celebrate Holy Mass in the Alexandrina Sanctuary of Balasar. We will have time for lunch and then continue to Porto. Upon arrival, we will have a panorama tour of the city. Dinner and overnight in Porto.

**DAY 12 — FRIDAY, JUNE 20 PORTO – U.S.A.** An early morning (6:00 am) transfer to the airport for our flight home.

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Itinerary is subject to change.

**AIR TRANSPORTATION:** Round trip economy class jet service provided, based on advance purchase fare, subject to participation of one person on the entire flight itinerary. Air fares subject to government approval/change without notice. Airline taxes and fees quoted are subject to change until the time of ticketing. Ave Maria Pilgrimage Tours, Inc., (referred to in this document as AMPT) is not responsible for any inconvenience, including refusal of boarding caused by tickets and travel documents not matching. Passenger must confirm that the name on the ticket matches exactly the name as shown on the passport. We ask that a copy of the passport information page be sent to us with your documents. Group ticketing does not always allow us to select seating. If a passenger has a medical need which requires specific seating it is recommended that a doctor's letter be presented. We will make an effort to accommodate your need, but cannot guarantee airline cooperation.

**LAND ONLY PACKAGES:** Any client who arranges their own air transportation takes sole responsibility for meeting the group at the time of our arrival. AMPT cannot be responsible for any misconnections. Client assumes full responsibility for catching up with the group and agrees to wait if the group is delayed for any reason. Client also agrees to assume the additional cost of transfers which do not coincide with the time and location of the group's schedule.

**BAGGAGE:** One piece of checked baggage and one carry on bag are allowed. Although the airlines may allow more than one piece of checked luggage, we must still restrict each passenger to one piece due to cargo hold size restrictions on buses. The maximum sizes and weights of these pieces are listed on the particular airline websites. It is recommended that you check these regulations prior to departure, please reference [www.tsa.gov](http://www.tsa.gov). Any fees for baggage are the responsibility of the traveler. Passenger is responsible for his/her own baggage and travel insurance is recommended.

**ACCOMMODATIONS:** Lodging is based on twin occupancy. For single accommodations (if available), a single room supplement will be quoted and may be charged. We reserve the right to substitute hotels as required. Breakfasts and dinners will be provided. Extra charges for additional beverages.

**LAND ARRANGEMENTS:** As outlined in the itinerary; however, we reserve the right to modify or adjust the itinerary.

**SIGHTSEEING:** By deluxe motor coach, where applicable, including services of English speaking guides. Most pilgrimages require a substantial amount of walking.
